

ECO-Vrindaban Board Meeting Minutes 10/30/2022

1. Ranaka's Monthly Report - September 2022

Ranaka reported on the previous month's projects:

- Lalita Gopi
 - o Temple Barn
 - There are seven cows giving milk: Surabhi, Usha, Jaya Radhe, Lalita, Vaisnavi, Gopi Katyayani, and Satyabhauma
 - There are three calves: Nrsimha, Vidya, and Padmagandha
 - The cows produce 28-30 gal of milk per day
 - Anandavidya makes 20-30 lb of butter weekly
 - Cleaned out the calf pen and removed the deep mud around the feeder.
 - Cleared the stones in the pastures around the barn and mowed.
 - Cleared the back walkway
 - Badarayani covered the milking on three occasions
 - Moved Puspavati to the Valley Barn to be with Dharma.
 - Nandagram
 - Josh is looking over the herd and doing maintenance.
- Josh
 - Cut grass and weed whacked at Vidya's and Nandagram.
 - Helped with the hay making operation.
 - Fed cows (bull and heifer).
 - Cleaned the feeding tray in the main barn.
- Ray

- Delivered hay to Temple Barn as needed.
- Fed and cleaned Valley Barns as needed.
- Maintained grass mowing and weed whacking around Valley Barns.
- Mowed, baled and stacked in the Valley and Nandagram Barns: 50 second-cutting round bales and 221 first-cutting round bales with the help of Josh Starkey and Pippalada. This brings the final yearly total to 1,175 round bales (966 first-cutting, 203 second-cutting, and six mulch). 24 of the first-cutting were dropped at the Bahulaban subdivision site to be used for mulch after the excavation is finished.
- Yudhisthira (New Yamuna Valley Farms Ox Report)
 - Gave one of the oxen a new nose ring
 - Japanese stick grass is invading the pastures which is requiring the oxen to eat more hay. They ate two round bales this month.
 - Yoked them up daily and they pulled a weighted sled around the pasture.
 - o Brushed them daily and fed them grain twice daily.
- Suchandra (Teaching Garden & Valley Barn Flower Beds)
 - Teaching Garden
 - Weeded and watered weekly.
 - Picked when needed.
 - Pulled some marigolds that had gotten moldy.
 - Deadheaded regularly.
 - Mowed and weed-whacked when needed.
 - Barn Beds
 - Weeded and watered weekly.
 - Harvested flowers regularly.
 - Deadheaded cannas and marigolds regularly.
 - Production from Teaching Garden & Barn Beds for September 2022
 - Basil 2 Bunches

 - Green Beans 3 lb
 - Marigolds, large 1,575

- Hari Nama (Vidya's Garden & High Tunnel)

- Weeded garden beds and high tunnel.
- Cut down asparagus.
- Weeded and mulched asparagus bed with straw.
- Weeded and mulched lily beds with straw.
- o Cleaned and covered the tomato bed.
- Weeded and mulched outdoor carnations.
- Pulled out dead marigold plants.
- Harvested bitter melon, loki, tomatoes, marigolds, carnations, dahlias, sunflowers, eucalyptus branches, and zinnias.
- Prepared some garden beds for manure and covering for winter.
- Stored tomato cages.
- Production from Vidya HT & Garden for September 2022:

- Analaksita (Valley High Tunnels & Outside Garden)
 - High Tunnel #1
 - Cleared the middle row of plants and prepped for tilling.
 - Fully harvested 1/4 of tomatoes and removed from trellising.
 - 270' of spinach seeded
 - Regularly watered and weeded
 - Harvested and delivered to the temple: celery, tomatoes, green beans, red chili, jalapeno, cayenne, habanero, red, yellow and orange bell peppers, cilantro, zinnia, dahlia, marigolds, tuber roses, and gardenias.
 - High Tunnel #2
 - Fully harvested and trimmed back all dahlias, eggplants, and bell pepper plants for winter.
 - Removed drip tape and walkway string from beds.
 - Tilled empty beds and replaced drip tape and walkway string.
 - Seeded 270' of spinach, 150' of carrot, 120' of beets, 100' of radishes (red and daikon), 100' of parsnip, 60' of cilantro, and 12 asparagus plants.
 - Regularly weeded and watered
 - Harvested and delivered to the temple: red, yellow, orange, and green bell

peppers, eggplant, green beans, mint, and dahlias

- Outdoor Garden
 - Harvested and delivered to the temple: cabbage, butternut squash, tomatoes, eggplant, ground cherry, corn, basil, zinnia, marigold, jalapeno, and red poblano peppers.
 - Regularly watered outdoor plants in pots
- Greenhouse
 - Moved grow stations into the greenhouse.
 - Sprouted and transplanted
 - Regularly watered
 - Ordered and gathered supplies such as potting soil, pots, screens for sides, gravel, electronic box for side panels, etc.
 - Decided upon a floor plan for the greenhouse. Researched options for the lights. We have a heater, but it needs to be looked at to see if it will work. I am hoping to be finished by the end of the month.
