1. Ranaka's Monthly Report - February 2023

Ranaka reported on the previous month's projects:

- Lalita Gopi (Temple Barn and Vidya's Garden and High Tunnel)
 - o Temple Barn
 - There are seven cows being milked: Subhadra, Lalita, Parijata, Usha, Vaisnavi, Radhika Keshavi, and Jayasri.
 - There are four calves at the barn: Padmagandha, Raghunath, Rupa and Makara.
 - Yasoda is due to have her baby calf within the month; we have her placed in the front field.
 - Rasalila has been milking the cows in the evenings.
 - The cows produce approximately 28 gallons of milk per day.
 - Anandavidya has resumed making butter after a long hiatus due to kitchen renovations.
- Hari Nama (Vidya's Garden & High Tunnel)
 - Loosened soil and added manure to the garden beds.
 - Weeded the garden and high tunnel.
 - Recovered the ground cover areas.
 - Cut and cleared All the dried tall grass.
 - Cleaned the garden tools and the garden shed area.

- Pruned the eucalyptus trees.
- Tuberoses were prepared for division.
- Prepared the beds to plant the tuberoses.
- Pruned the carnations to promote new growth.
- Prepared the beds for planting.
- Started the marigolds for early planting in the high tunnel.
- Josh Starkey (Nandagram)
 - Cleaned the trash around the cabin.
 - Placed 12 bales into the bigger barn twice this month.
 - Drove T-posts for the fence to separate the bull pen from the main herd.
 - Fixed the ATV trailer, and cleared the trash.
 - Dewormed the herd last month, has shown positive progress.
 - Installed gates in the barn to keep the cows from opening the doors.
 - Rebuilt the sandstone wall in the garden area at the Garden House.
- Ray
- Delivered hay to Temple Barn, fed & cleaned the Valley Barns as needed.
- Cleaned out 200' drainage ditch & removed old culvert on the Valley Barn bottom with backhoe.
- Picked up & installed a new 18" x 20' culvert connecting fields on the Valley Barn bottom.
- Harvested 20' locust posts from the woods for the lame cow pen expansion.
- Attached locust post to truss & floor in the Valley Barn to move the gates back for the lame cow area expansion.
- Repaired The fence at Vidya's Garden
- Designed & installed hanging hose systems for both the Valley High Tunnels.
- Yudhisthira das (The New Yamuna Valley Farms) Ox Training Report
 - Trained the oxen almost every day except when the weather did not permit.
 - The oxen are in excellent health & are responding well to voice commands.
 - Made a proposal for the potential ox program at the Community Garden.
- Badarayani (Ox Program)
 - Fed all 4 oxen: Govardhan, Nandalal, Kaustubh and Nrsimha.
 - Trained Govardhan and Nrsimha individually.
 - Yoked Nandalal and Kaustubh with a pole in the middle and trained. This helps us in hooking them up with a cart or a plow as both oxen get used to the pole between them.
 - Trained Govardhan to pull ox carts and he is comfortable with it.
 - Trained Govardhan with pulling a log.

- Developing a relationship with Raghunath and trained him with basic commands.
- Milked Cows once a week.
- Suchandra (Valley High Tunnels One and Two plus Greenhouse & Outside Garden)
 - o Crew: Lila & Bhumika
 - o High Tunnel 1
 - Laid gravel in front of the high tunnel.
 - Removed arugula plants that were bolting.
 - Thinned spinach out.
 - Planted more spinach and parsley to help control aphids.
 - Ray hung the water hose on the line in the high tunnel to keep the hose off ground.
 - Moved the seed shelf to the greenhouse.
 - Direct seeded romaine lettuce.
 - Transplanted arugula, mixed greens, and broccoli into beds.
 - Weeded and watered as needed.
 - Harvested & delivered to Temple: Arugula, Kale, Spinach, Bok-choy, Collard greens, Rainbow chard, Chidimisai, and Chinese cabbage.
 - Covered and uncovered plants as needed.
 - Transplanted celery in the first row that was coming up from the old batch and moved some into pots and then moved to the greenhouse.

o High Tunnel 2

- Cut and switched out cages for dahlias, used small pieces in between cages for peas.
- Laid gravel in the front entryway of the tunnel.
- Planted cauliflower.
- Thinned out spinach bed.
- Planted spinach and parsley in the spinach bed and another bed.
- Ray hung a water hose on line to keep off the ground.
- Cleared chijimisai out to make room for other plants.
- Harvested carrots, beets, radishes, daikon radish, and spinach, washed and brought to the temple.
- Weeded and watered as needed.
- Covered and uncovered plants as needed.
- Moved scale into high tunnel and moved sink from greenhouse to the high tunnel.

Outside Garden

- Planted gladiolus behind the high tunnels.
- Bhumika delivered produce to the devotees.
- Bhumika & Suchandra met with Grow Ohio Valley to learn about growing micro plants.
- Added dirt around the high tunnel edges to fill in the gaps.
- Made garden signs to mark what was planted in rows for the outdoor garden.
- Greenhouse

- Turned on the heat
- Bhumika moved the transplants to tables.
- Moved metal potting soil bin onto the cinder blocks.
- Lila moved the shelf warmer to the greenhouse and reassembled it.
- Watered plants in the greenhouse.
- Lila moved bags of potting soil inside.
- Started seeds and transplanted.
- Barn beds
 - Lila cleaned up, removed plastic and dug the old canna bulbs up.
 - Planted gladiolus bulbs in the area behind bed where the shrubs are.
- Teaching Garden
 - Cleaned up the beds and the garden of twigs, pulled up plants and leaves.
 - Planted some gladiola bulbs in the other beds.
 - Took fencing up in the back area of the garden.
 - Weeded lily/gladiola beds to get ready for mulch.
